## **Rules and Regulations — Please Read Carefully**

### Eligibility of Work

- This exhibit is open to all forms of art, including, but not limited to: pen & ink, watercolour, acrylic, pastel, charcoal, multi-media, oil, stained glass, photography, sculpture, etc.
- Only original works are permitted (reproductions of other artists' work will not be accepted).
- Works which have been shown previously are **NOT** permitted.
- A maximum of two works per artist will be accepted. Maximum width for pieces is 40 inches. maximum weight is 20 lbs.
- Pieces do not have to be framed, however, they must be secured with wire of sufficient gauge to hang the piece. Sculptures must be freestanding.

### Exhibition Hours

- The gallery will be open 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Tuesday to Saturday excluding holidays.
- Exhibition of display Tuesday, May 7 to Saturday, June 15, 2024

### Delivery & Pick-up of Work

- All pieces must be delivered to the
- **Wallaceburg & District Museum (505 King Street, Wallaceburg, Ontario) from Saturday, April 27 to Saturday May, 4, 2024** between the hours of 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- All art must be picked up in person by **Saturday, June 15, 2024 @ 4pm**
- Any work left behind after this date will be deemed abandoned and relinquished to the museum. Please make sure the museum staff are aware if you require an extension and we would be happy to hold your items until you are able to collect.

### Ceremony and Awards

- AWARDS NIGHT CEREMONY will be held
- **Thursday, June 13, 2024 starting 6 p.m. to 7pm. Awards given at 6:15pm**
- Awards and cash prizes will be presented for: Exhibit winner 1st, 2nd and 3rd. People's Choice 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

### Purchase of Work

- Artists are to indicate on their entry label whether their work is for sale, along with contact information which will be given to interested parties.
- The Wallaceburg & District Museum will not be charging commission for pieces sold during the show.

### Additional Terms

- The Wallaceburg and District Museum has the right to photograph artists and their artwork for publicity and web posting
- Although the utmost care will be taken, the Museum is not responsible for lost or damaged pieces and reserves the right to refuse any works it deems unsuitable.
